

Guidelines for Presentation

Flow:

1. Introduction
 - brief background info about the province/study area (ex. site description, extent, location, known for, number of barangays); awards/recognitions received
 - importance of mangroves to the community
2. Status of mangroves in the province/study area
 - extent - natural, planted, restored
 - maps (if available, before and after management or after disturbance such as typhoons)
 - number of restoration/rehabilitation projects
 - initiatives on mangrove conservation other than mangrove planting
 - location and size/extent of degraded mangroves
 - perceived threats to mangrove ecosystem
3. Mangrove Protection and Management
 - Rehabilitation programs (process); funding source; year started
 - Monitoring and Evaluation (growth and survival rate)
 - Impacts of mangrove rehabilitation in terms of ecosystem and socio-economic contributions (e.g. food, income)
4. Summary and Recommendations
5. References
